Yearbook pictures will be taken on Tuesday, November 8 at 3 p.m. Please change into your complete uniform after school and meet on the field.

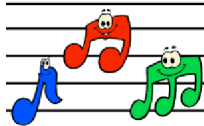
Volleyball: jersey & shorts

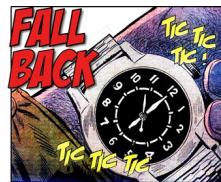

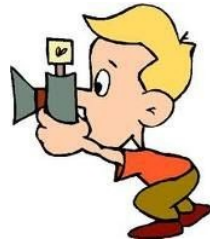

If you forgot the payment envelope on photo day and meant to purchase pictures, you may do so on re-take day. **Students taking pictures must be in dress uniform.**

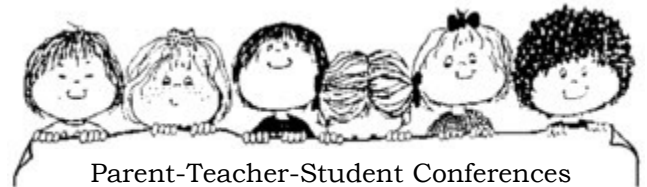

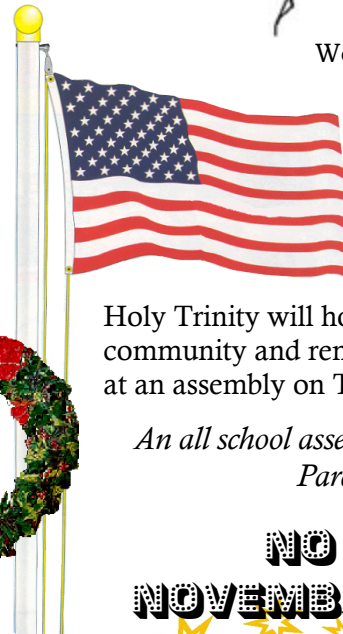
Orders due...
