We thank you for your cooperation in keeping this a fun-filled day for our students!

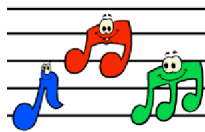

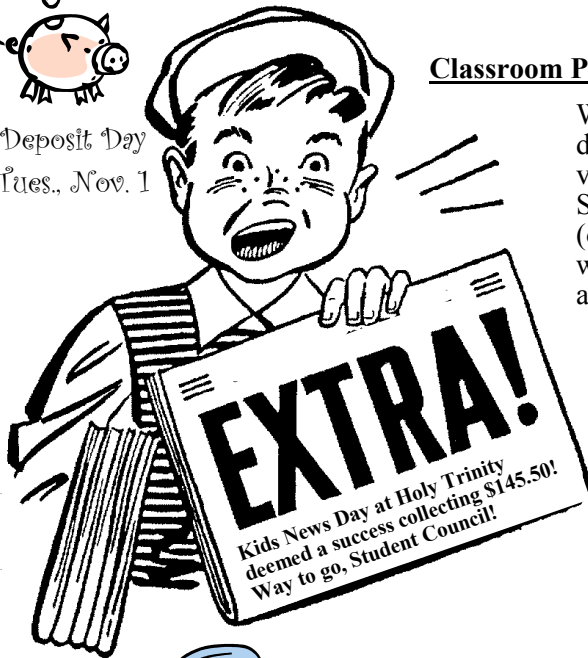
