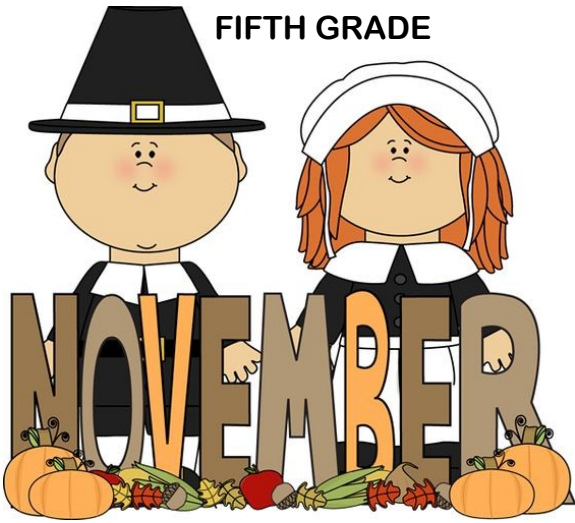

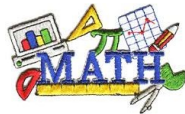
Nov. 10<sup>th</sup>-No School in observance of Veteran's Day
