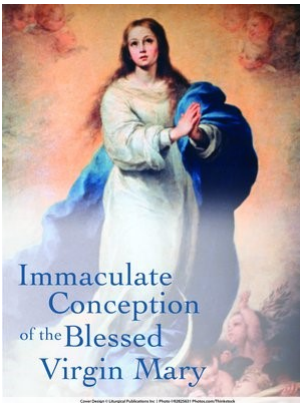


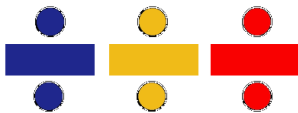
December

In language arts, we will focus on writing a paragraph, including topic and supporting sentences, and when and where to use commas.

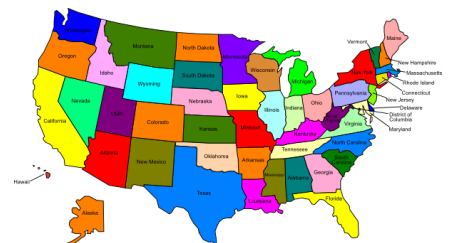


In science, we will be learning about electricity and magnetism, laws of motion, and technology of the past and present.
