

Just a reminder...

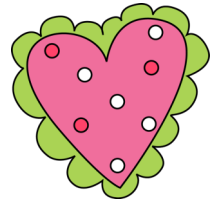


Remember, Grandparent's day is on Friday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, the end of Catholic Schools' Week. Please check

In religion, we learn about Jesus, the healer and Mary, the model of discipleship. We also talk about the sacrament of anointing of the sick.

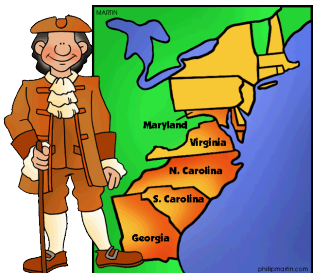


In math, we will move on to chapter 5 and 6. Students will learn to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions.
