

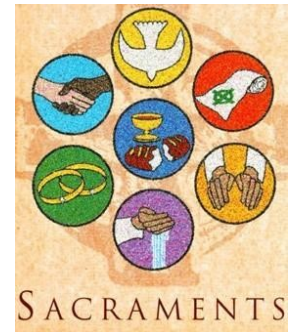
Fifth Grade

In religion, we will read about the sacraments of matrimony and holy orders. We will also read about the foundations of the church and learn why it is one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic.

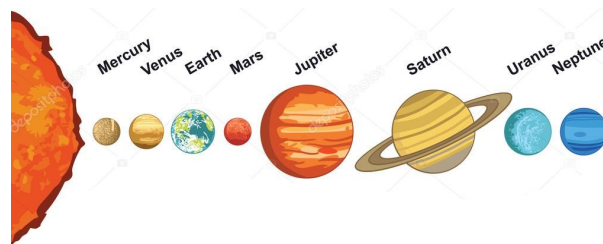

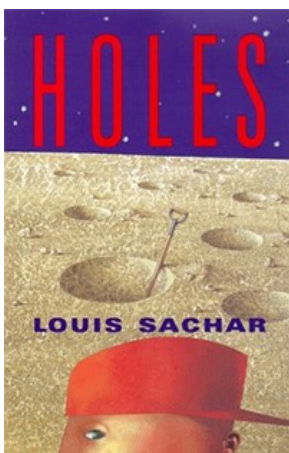
In math, we take a break from fractions and move into the adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing of decimals.



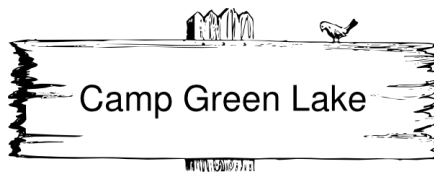
