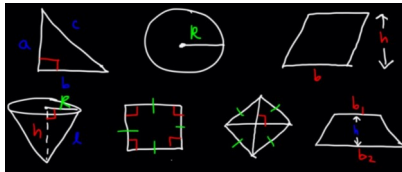


## Fifth Grade



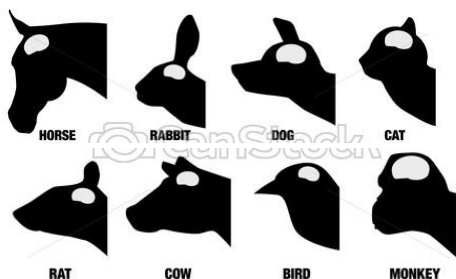
Our focus in the month of May will be on family life.

In math, we learn how to multiply and divide decimals. We will also dive into geometry.

In social studies, we will read weeks 23 through 26. We study the major military battles, campaigns, and turning points of the Revolutionary War. Students will learn about the different roles women played during the Revolution and the impact and economic hardship of the war on families.



In science, we transition into life science and learn about cells, plants, animals, and the human organism.

Students will learn about our amazing brain and compare the brains of various animals.



In language arts, students will learn about contractions, homophones, adjectives, and adverbs. Students will practice where to use these when writing sentences.
