Dear Fourth Grade Parents,

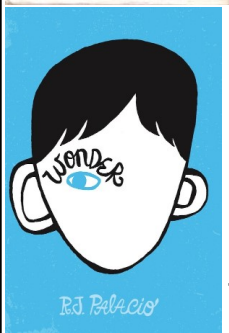
