my students and all their hard work. I can't wait for them to share these projects on Grandparents' Day.



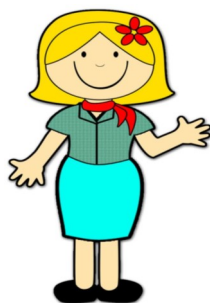
