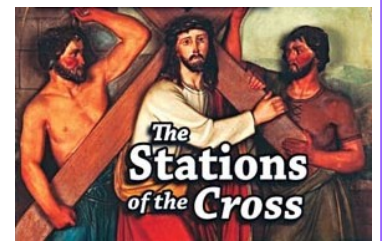


### Gold Rush Day
