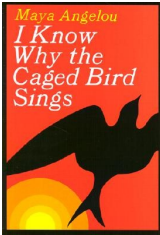


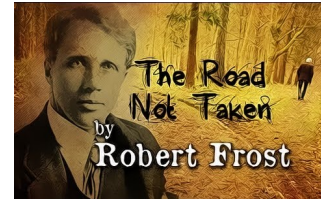

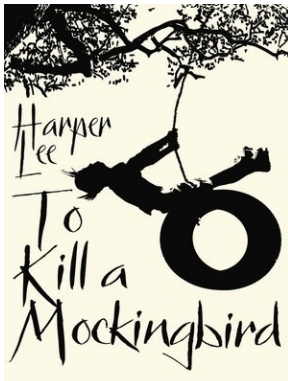
In grammar we are working on chapter 2 of the grammar textbook as students are learning about fragments and run-on sentences.
