

## Second Grade



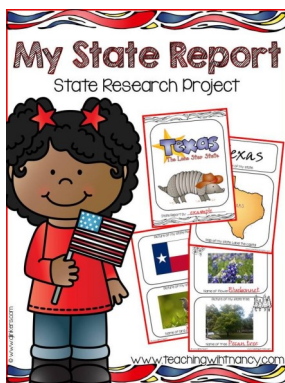
Dear Second Grade Parents,
