September


I would like to welcome you and your child to Holy Trinity for the 2018-2019 school year. Our sharing day will be on **Fridays only!** If your child has something to share with us, he or she may bring it to class on any Friday. Please send a water bottle with your child every day with his/her name labeled clearly on the bottle. Please fill the water bottle with **water only!** No juice, please! The children will use their water bottles at snack time and throughout the day. They will be permitted to drink juice at lunch time.



Each child needs to bring a backpack to school daily. There is a homework paper that will be sent home for you to work on everyday with your child and sent back to school the following day. I have found that the most efficient means of getting that homework paper home is a backpack. **NO ROLLING BACKPACKS PLEASE!**



We need to have an earthquake supply bag in the classroom for every child. If you have not sent in your supply bag, please do so as soon as possible.



Monday, August 20th was our **Back to School Night**. I enjoyed meeting the parents of my students and look forward to a wonderful year of learning, exploring and collaborating together, as we work in partnership for the educational and spiritual well-being of your child. Parent, teacher and student communication is a key ingredient to the success your child will experience this year. I will post a monthly class letter on the school's website along with a monthly list of High Frequency Words we will be learning in the classroom. I will, also, send class emails throughout the month to keep you informed and up-dated, or contact you by phone, when necessary. So, please do not hesitate to contact me through emails or phone messages, if you have any questions or concerns. We are working together to make this year in Kindergarten memorable, fun-filled, and a positive beginning for your child's academic success!



Our first school Mass is on Tuesday, September 18th at 11:00am. Dress uniform is required for all students. As I explained at our Back to School night, the kindergarten class will be having PE two times a week. Their PE days are Mondays and Fridays after lunch for the remainder of the school year. On these days, your child needs to come to school dressed in their PE uniform, unless it happens to be a school Mass day. On a school Mass day, they need to come in their dress uniform, but bring their PE clothes in their backpacks for changing into the appropriate uniform after Mass.
