Dear Parents,

Can you feel the weather beginning to change? Yes, fall is almost upon us! With our school year well underway, I'd like to offer some clarification on a couple rules and procedures.

1. **Cell Phones** - Students are not permitted to bring cell phones to school at any time. This includes keeping them in their backpacks and turned off. If there is an extenuating circumstance, please contact the office to make arrangements for it to be left in our care until your child is picked-up at the end of the day. There are several phones, both landline and cell on campus at any given time...one in each classroom and each staff member has one too. Therefore, additional phones are not necessary. If a student brings a phone to school, it will be placed in the office for a parent to retrieve.

Failure to adhere to this school rule will affect your child's report card behavior grade.

2. **Early Drop-off**- Any student dropped-off in front of the school in the morning and not signing into daycare, **must** be accompanied by a parent on campus until 7:50 (first bell). If you are just dropping off and do not want to be charged for daycare you must drive to the back gate and wait for it to be opened at 7:50. All students entering the front gate in the morning will be admitted to daycare. This is for their safety; we do not have staff monitoring the school grounds before 7:50.

I thank you, in advance, for your cooperation and support. Teaching children to follow and obey rules, even ones they do not like or agree with, is a valuable "Life Lesson". You, as parents, are a huge part of this lesson as well. When you show your support for us, this lesson becomes even more valuable. We have an amazing community here, working together for the best possible academic, spiritual and character education for our children. It is an awesome endeavor, but well worth the effort. 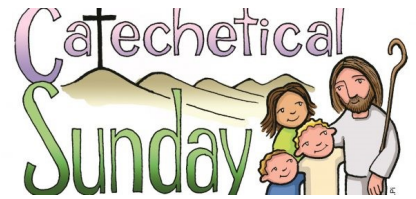
