*Parent/teacher conferences will be on Nov. 8th & 9th. Please make sure you are on time, so we can have our full 15 minutes together. Thank you in advance.

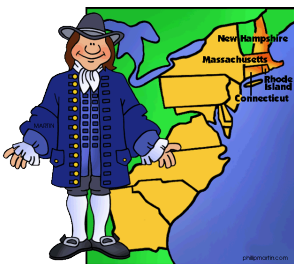


In religion, we begin Unit 2. We will learn about the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist, and how they complete our

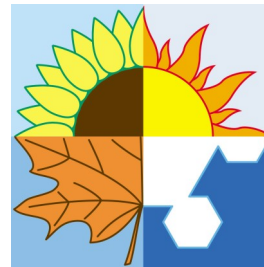


initiation.

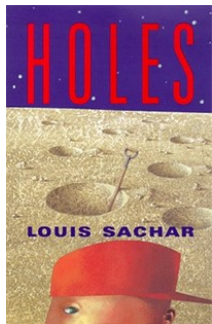
In math, we continue in Chapter 3 on division. We learn about division patterns, long & short division, divisibility, and compatible numbers.
