I want to take this opportunity to thank all our wonderful

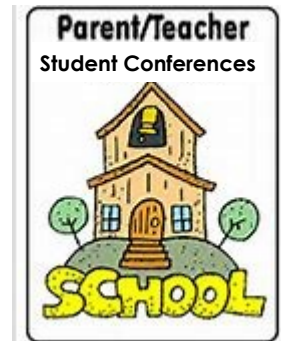


volunteers for our special Halloween celebration in the classroom.
