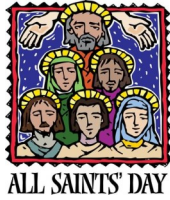


November is going to be a very busy month preparing for Thanksgiving and Advent!

We will study possessive nouns, verbs and conventions of grammar (*capitalization, punctuation, subject-verb agreement*) in November.



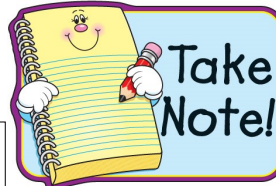
Reading
