In math, we take a break from fractions and move into adding and subtracting decimals.

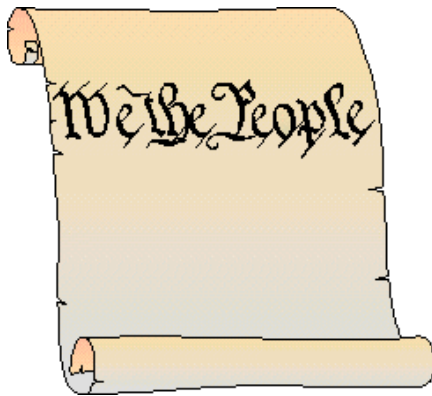

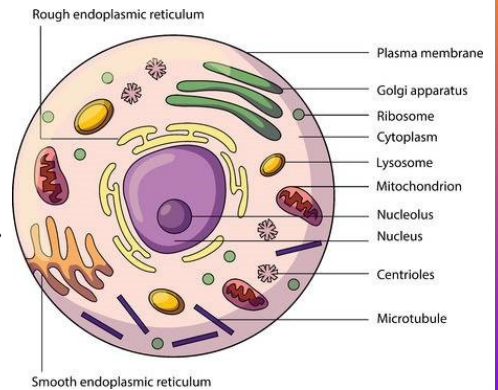
