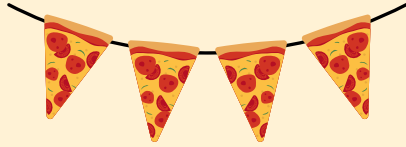

Lunch for all grades is from 12:00 - 12:40 pm

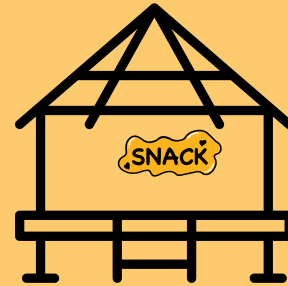
- Grades K-2 lunch is taken to the tables by 12:00 pm

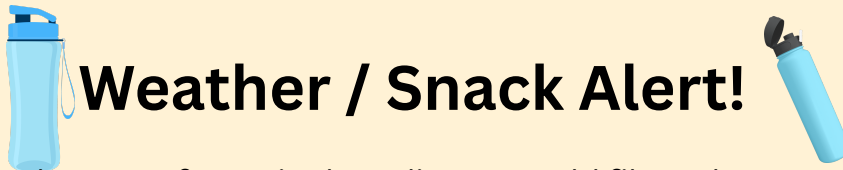

Sign up to help out at the Snack Shack on Saturday's!

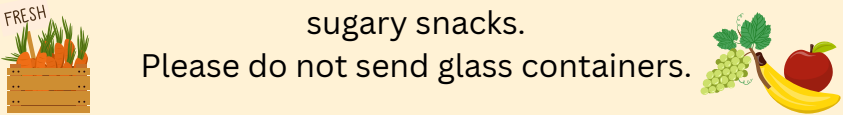


Weather / Snack Alert!

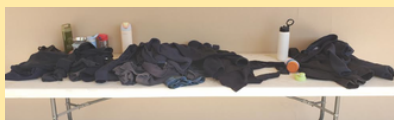
