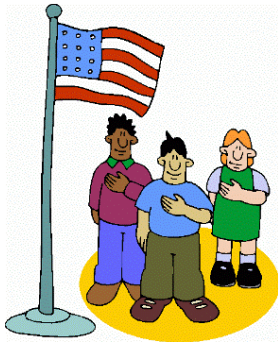

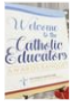
Enter service hours from a computer. It's been said it is difficult to enter from a cell phone. If you need assistance with logging in, please contact Mrs. Cota. Thank you.
